GENEROUS EYES

Generosity gives us the eyes to see the more that we are called to!

As Achan's greed entered the camp and halted the Israelites possession of the promised land, we are asking the question, what can stop us from entering into the more God has for us? The opposite spirit of greed is generosity and that is what we want to look at and cultivate as a key characteristic of our community.

GENEROSITY IS THE MORE THAT GOD HAS FOR US

*Matt 6:22-23 - ²² "The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are **healthy**, your whole body will be full of light. ²³ But if your eyes are unhealthy, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!*

** The Greek for healthy here implies generous.*

In Matthew 6:19-24 we have Jesus' vision of Kingdom generosity. If your eyes are **generous**, your whole body will be full of light. But if your eyes are greedy, your whole body will be full of darkness. Living with generous eyes is part of Jesus' vision of how to enter into the more we are made for.
